### Reporting Agencies

The agencies above can help you determine the correct substation or agency to which you are to report. Do not be dissuaded if you must make a few calls to reach the right agency.

For children who are in **imminent danger**, have **visible injuries**, or **disclose sexual abuse**, a mandated reporter should call the **Local Law Enforcement Agency** that covers the location in which the suspected abuse occurred. Otherwise, call DCFS. Please talk with your school-site administrator to determine which Local Law Enforcement Agency or agencies cover your location.
